



## Elizabeth Jean Harrison

March 31, 1926 - September 25, 2022

Elizabeth Jean Harrison, 96, passed away at home in Okanogan on Sept. 25th, 2022. She was born on March 31st, 1926, in Minneapolis, Minnesota to Lawrence and Frances Norris. The family later relocated to Washington State where her father was a pharmacist throughout her youth in Seattle, Cashmere, and Wenatchee.
