Our beautiful beloved Mickey graduated to heaven Oct. 13, 2024. He loved life, his family, his community and most of all Jesus. He lived an amazing life with the love of his life and wife of nearly 30 years Shannon by his side. Together they raised three beautiful children— Sonya, Krystianna and Alec— and in recent years added a son-in- law Mario and spunky granddaughter Isabella to the bunch. They were his greatest pride and joy.

Mickey lived a life on the edge. His passions included skiing, climbing, sailing, cycling, wrestling and football, and really any sport that got him outside—all of which he did with excellence. At one point in his teenage years, he was among the top five junior cyclists in the state of Washington and went to the junior nationals. He was a state wrestling champion and had college offers for both wrestling and football. In more recent years he pursued these passions by coaching both wrestling and football. Being a part of training boys into men both on and off the field or mat was something he took great pride in and was more than just a job but a calling for him.

He also spent nearly 35 years working in the woods as a logger. He was happiest with a chainsaw on his shoulder walking down into the rigging to cut the biggest trees he could find. By the end of his career, he had worked in nearly every aspect of the industry and was passionate about stewarding the forest the way God intended for us to. But also, he just wanted to cut really big

timber.

Many knew Mickey as Pastor. For over 20 years he has been a part of church pastorship, starting as a youth pastor where he influenced countless young lives, teaching them the gospel and discipling them.
