



## Nancy Erickson

April 5, 1956 - July 23, 2025

ERICKSON, Nancy J. (Age 69) peacefully entered into rest on July 24, 2025. Born on April 5, 1956, in San Diego, CA, Nancy was the eldest daughter of Delbert “Swede” and Eunice Erickson. Her younger sister, Terrie, soon joined the family, and together they spent 16 years in San Diego while Swede was stationed there with the Navy. The family later settled in Spokane, WA, where Nancy attended Shadle Park High School. She married Mike Norman in 1976, and together they were blessed with two sons, Chris and Jon.

In 1989, Nancy relocated to Okanogan and planted roots in the community she would grow to love. She married Jeff Delfeld, and with him came her stepson, Pat Delfeld, whom she welcomed into her life with open arms. Nancy began working for the school transportation department in 1996. 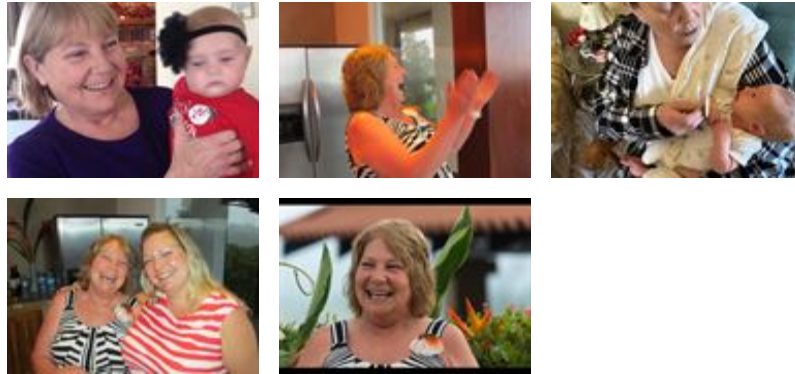
