We are deeply saddened to share that Rodney Hunter, our beloved brother, father, grandfather and friend, passed away unexpectedly at home in Winthrop on April 17, 2025. Rodney grew up in Ketchikan, Alaska, and spent time in the Methow Valley during his youth visiting his grandparents. Those early experiences gave him a lasting appreciation for the outdoors and led to a career as a commercial fisherman. Later, he returned to the valley to raise his family in the same home his grandparents once lived in. A proud Marine, Rodney served with honor during the Vietnam War. He brought that same sense of duty into every part of his life. In his later years, he found joy in the rhythm of the seasons — hunting camp in the fall, fishing trips to Alaska in the summer, and winter travels to warmer places like Arizona, Hawaii, and Vietnam. Rodney was preceded in death by his parents, Robert and Jesse Hunter, and his younger brother, James “Jimmy” Hunter. He is survived by his lifelong partner, Jeannie Hunter; his brother Ricky; his sister and brother-in-law, Judy and Jerry Andrist; his children, Brandon (Megan) and Audrey (Josh); his grandchildren, Kassandra and Zackary; his great-grandson, Daniel; and his nieces and nephews: Jeremy, Madyson, Bella, Jamey (Jeffrey), Joseph, Jackey, Justin and Sean.
