He grew up in Malott and attended the Malott Elementary School; and during that time when a in little league baseball coached by Stan Stout as a star pitcher and played in the Wenatchee all star game. His last employment he worked for AAOA out of the Omak Tribal Office. Terry left AAOA to take care of his wife until her death in 2012, who he was married to for 25 years. Terry has been a member of the 1910 Indian Shaker Church for 47 years. He had held a few titles of the church and Bishop for a 4 year term and minister for a life term. Terry held many titles and traveled to all of the 1910 Shaker churches to help out and be a part of their family lives as well as into Canada, California, Idaho where brother Terry was well respected. Terry would help anyone out by splitting wood, shovel, pack or stack, mow the yards as well as taking care of the family Chiliwist Cemetery plot which was taught to him by his father, T.B.-Sxakin. Terry was a member of Colville Confederated Tribes/Methow Band.
