William Patrick (Pat) Juetten, 91, Spokane, Wash. died Dec. 21, 2022, at Royal Park Retirement in Spokane. He was born July 14, 1931, in Oshkosh, Wisc., to Ed Juetten and Helen (McCarthy) Juetten.
